

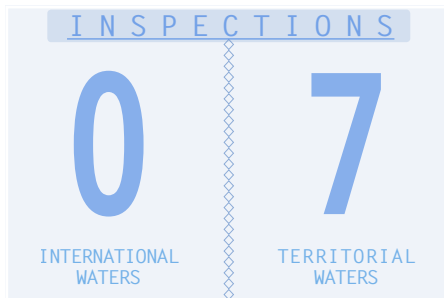

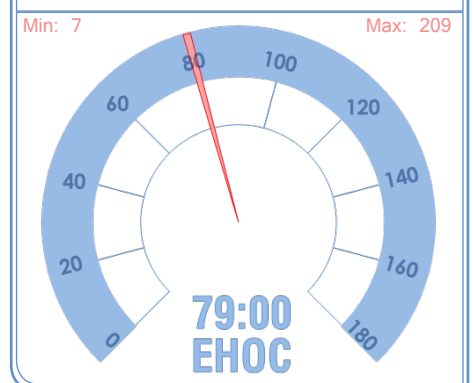


TOTAL CARGO DISCHARGED (t)

AVERAGE PRE-CLEARANCE PROCESSING TIME HOURS



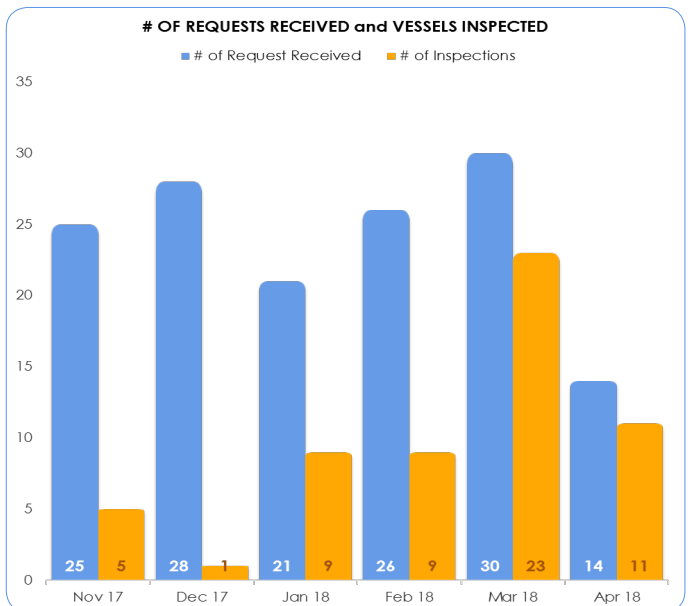
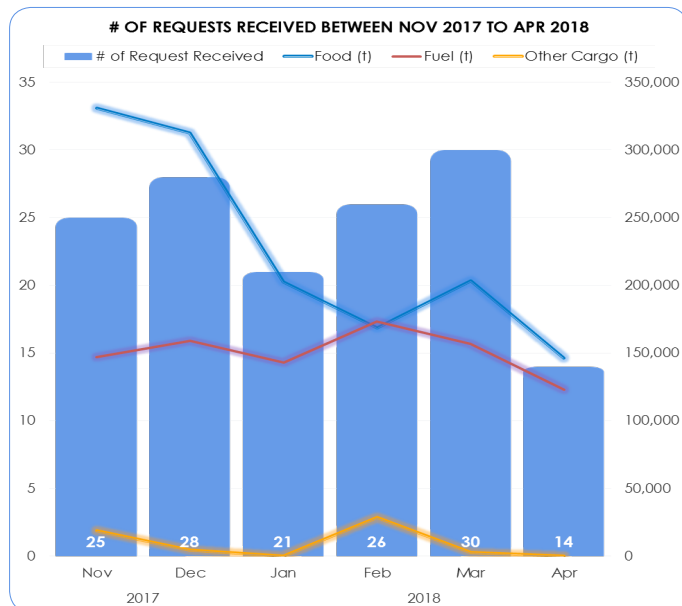
VESSELS AWAITING PERMISSION FROM COALITION TO ENTER ANCHORAGE AREA - 10 APRIL

* On 28 March 2018 UNVIM received a clearance request from a ship vessel transporting vehicles destined for Hodeidah. UNVIM inspected the vessel on 4 April and recommended it for clearance. On 10 April UNVIM was informed by EHOc that the vessel had also submitted a clearance request for Aden and that EHOc had approved this request. The vessel therefore withdrew its clearance request from UNVIM and proceeded to Aden.
